St Elizabeth's Church is observing the restrictions of the civil authority which currently require us to have a gathering of no more the 25% of normal capacity, which we conservatively estimate at this time to be twenty (20) persons, who can space themselves six (6) feet apart. Parishioners are asked to take turns attending the services offered in church. The Parish is using an internet service called 'Sign-Up Genius'. With this tool we allow the first 20 who register to attend a service inside. All others will participate in the services from the pavilion, where we have a live video and audio feed of the service as it happens inside the church.
