In previous years the celebration of the Holy Prince Vladimir, Equal of the Apostles — the Saint who brought the peoples of 'Rus to holy baptism — has been observed solemnly at St Vladimir's Memorial Church in Jackson, New Jersey. Many of the clergy and the faithful from the parishes in New Jersey and the surrounding area would gather in Jackson for the St Vladimir's celebrations on the Sunday nearest his feast day.
